Tue 18 Apr	(Arrive in Fiumicino Airport) Palermo	L D	PALERMO
	After transferring from Rome Fiumicino Airport, the tour begins in Palermo with a light welcome lunch at the hotel, followed by a tour of the Historic Centre in the afternoon.		
Wed 19 Apr	Monreale	B L	PALERMO
	The morning is spent first on an excursion to Monreale to see the spectacular Cathedral, and then back to Palermo to visit the typical street markets of the city reflecting influences of the various cultures which have dominated the region. The afternoon is left at your leisure.		
Thu 20 Apr	Segesta, Erice	B D	PALERMO
	The first of the ancient Greek temples awaits you this morning at Segesta, before visiting Erice, an beautiful Medieval town perched on a hill 750m above the sea. While here we visit Maria Grammatico's pastry shop to taste her celebrated marzipan and nougat creations.		
Fri 21 Apr	Vineyard	B L D	AGRIGENTO
	Today we transfer to Agrigento, but only after a lunch in a vineyard where we shall spend a relaxing afternoon tasting some of the best Sicilian wines and olive oils.		
Sat 22 Apr	Valley of the Temples	B D	AGRIGENTO
	This morning we visit one of Sicily's most important Greek colonies, within which is the famous Valley of Temples stunningly set against the sea. The evening will see us enjoying dinner in a real family home, where a local folk group will entertain with a performance of traditional serenades and dances.		
Sun 23 Apr	Piazza Armerina	B D	SIRACUSA
	We leave the coast this morning to venture into the interior of Sicily, where shall visit the extraordinary ancient Roman mosaics of the Villa del Casale in Piazza Armerina. We then head on to Siracusa on the eastern coast, where we shall explore the Historic Centre with our guide.		
Mon 24 Apr	Historic Centre of Siracusa	B L	SIRACUSA
	This morning we explore the Historic Centre together with our guide, including the most ancient nucleus of Ortigia, followed by a visit to a delicatessen for a tasting of the local charcuterie, leaving the evening to your leisure.		
Tue 25 Apr	Ragusa, Modica and Noto	B	SIRACUSA
	Baroque is the theme for today, with visits to the towns of Modica and Noto which are considered to be two of the finest examples of the style created following a major earthquake in 1693. In the midst of this sumptuous architecture, we shall also have tasting of their specialty chocolates and granite siciliana.		
Wed 26 Apr	Mount Etna	B L D	SALINA
	We leave Siracusa today to explore the awe-inspiring Mount Etna, Europe's highest volcano, after which we head to Milazzo for the transfer by hydrofoil to the island resort of Salina.

Salina

We tour Salina this morning by bus, with the afternoon left free for you to enjoy the relaxing atmosphere of the island, or visit the other Aeolian Islands.

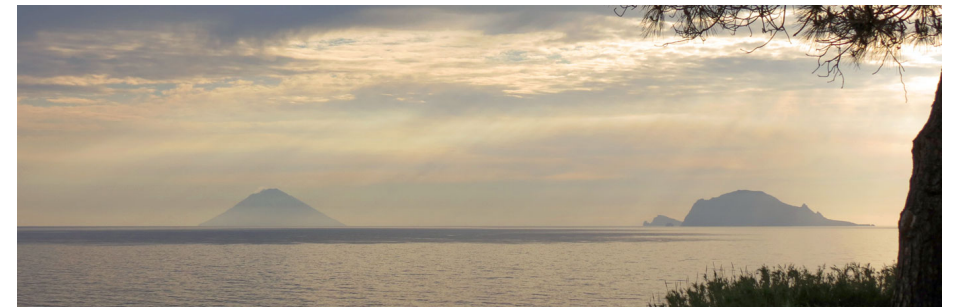
