



Wed 2 May	Herculaneum B L NAPLES Herculaneum is the focus of the morning, one of ancient Roman towns buried during the volcanic eruption of Vesuvius in AD79. The afternoon is left at your leisure with unlimited free travel on local public transport.				
Thu 3 May	Reggia di Caserta B L D ROME This morning we visit the Royal Palace and Gardens in Caserta, a UNESCO World Heritage Site often used as a setting in movies, before we head for Rome for our final night of the tour.				
Fri 4 May	Transfer will be provided after breakfast this morning from your hotel to the airport.
