Thu 7 May	Reggia di CasertaBDROMEThis morning we visit the Royal Palace and Gardens in Caserta, a UNESCO World Heritage Site often used as a setting in movies, before we head for Rome for our final night of the tour.		
Fri 8 May	Transfer will be provided after breakfast this morning from your hotel to the airport.
