Sat 24 Oct	Como	L	Overnight COMO
	<i>Pick-up is provided from Milan Malpensa airport in the morning to take you to your hotel in Como. Your guide shall take you around lovely lakeside resort after lunch, with a visit via funicular to the village of Brunate for a spectacular view of the lake.</i>		
Sun 25 Oct	Lake Como	B L	COMO
	<i>This morning we explore the lake itself by private boat, with a stopover in Bellagio where you can enjoy the panorama of the entire lake.</i>		
Mon 26 Oct	Lake Como	B D	COMO
	<i>We continue the exploration of the wonderful scenery around the lake today, this time by bus along the western edge, with a visit to Villa Carlotta.</i>		
Tue 27 Oct	Milan Expo	B	COMO
	<i>The entire day is dedicated to visiting the Milan Universal Exposition. A bus transfer is provided to take you to the fairground in the morning, returning in the evening.</i>		
Wed 28 Oct	St. Moritz, Bernina Express	B D	TIRANO
	<i>We leave for St. Moritz this morning, from which we shall take the Bernina Express train to Tirano, along the railway which has been a UNESCO World Heritage since 2008.</i>		
Thu 29 Oct	Livigno, Bormio	B L	TIRANO
	<i>Today's excursion takes us to the ski resort of Livigno, which due to a quirk of history also happens to offer duty-free shopping. A visit to a dairy farm follows with lunch, then a visit to the spa and ski resort of Bormio, where you have the option of indulging in a bath fed by one of the nearby thermal springs.</i>		
Fri 30 Oct	Teglio	B L	TIRANO
	<i>We head for the nearby village of Teglio this morning to visit Palazzo Besta, one of the best preserved Renaissance residences in existence. After lunch is a lesson in making a local pasta called pizzoccheri!</i>		
Sat 31 Oct	Bergamo	B L D	BERGAMO
	<i>This morning takes us to Bergamo where before checking into your hotel we shall visit an organic vineyard and stop by for lunch as well. Later in the afternoon we shall explore this fascinating medieval town with our expert guide.</i>		
Sun 1 Nov	Trescore, vinegar works	B D	BERGAMO
	<i>The programme for today is Cappella Suardi in the town of Trescore Balneario, and then a visit to the only facility in Lombardy which makes balsamic vinegar. Here we shall do some tasting with wines and typical food products before heading back to Bergamo to spend the afternoon at your leisure.</i>		

Mon 2 Nov **Dairy farm and cheese factory** **B D** **BERGAMO**
Today we discover the secrets of cheese-making when we visit a typical cheese factory in one of the Bergamasque valleys.

Tue 3 Nov **B D** **MILAN**
We make our way to Milan today, where you are free to enjoy the sights or do some shopping with unlimited use of public transport. A seafood feast awaits for your farewell dinner.

Wed 4 Nov *Transfer shall be provided after breakfast this morning to Malpensa airport.*
