Tue 15 Oct (Arrival in Bari Airport, transfer to Tenuta Monacelle) D

T. Monacelle **A scenic transfer is provided after** arrival at Bari airport to take you to your trulli in a country estate where you shall be staying for the next 5 nights. A sumptuous dinner awaits in the evening.

Wed 16 Oct Alberobello BL

> A UNESCO World heritage Site since 1996, Alberobello is the capital of trulli, with over 1000 of these unique buildings making up the town. After a walking tour and lunch in this fascinating place, we visit a mozzarella production where we shall taste some of their products.

Thu 17 Oct Grotte di Castellana, Noci T. Monacelle

> This morning's excursion takes you to one of the most important speleological sites in Europe, after which we transfer to the village of Noci where we shall lunch at a famous local restaurant, followed by a brief walk with the guide through this picturesque place.

Martina Franca, Locorotondo T. Monacelle Fri 18 Oct

> Baroque style is the theme of today, starting with Martina Franca where we shall explore its winding streets with our guide before we embark on a special e-bike tour through the countryside all the way to Locorotondo, considered one of the most beautiful villages in Italy.

Sat 19 Oct Ostuni, Olive farm ΒL T. Monacelle

> We make our way this morning to a private estate for a tasting of extra virgin oil pressed from the olives of centuries-old trees, followed by a guided visit to the famous "white city" of Ostuni.

Sun 20 Oct Monopoli, Polignano a Mare MATERA

Today we explore two of the many seaside towns of the region, first being the fortified city of Monopoli, and then to the more intimate more ancient Polignano a Mare where we shall have some free time to enjoy the ambience before we head for Matera to spend the next three nights.

Mon 21 Oct Matera, Bakery MATERA

> The incredible beauty of this UNESCO World Heritage Site and European Capital of Culture for 2019 shall be revealed this morning in guided tour of its ancient sassi. We then make a short trip to nearby Altamura to visit an ancient bakery and taste its famous bread.

Tue 22 Oct (Free day) MATERA

The entire day is left free for you to explore the labyrinthine streets of this stunning town.

Wed 23 Oct Lecce T. Monacelli

> We make our way to Lecce this morning, where our guide shall lead us around this magnificent masterpiece of Baroque architecture. The afternoon is then left at your leisure to enjoy the town before we make our way to a farm to spend the next three nights.

Thu 24 Oct Gallipoli, cooking class

ΒL T. Monacelli We shall have some fun this morning participating in a cooking lesson with seafood in the famous

town of Gallipoli, with the afternoon spent at leisure before head back to Tenuta Monacelli.

Fri 25 Oct Santa Cesarea Terme, Otranto ΒL T. Monacelli

> We head for the easternmost spot of the country today, visiting two towns, one a thermal spring resort once frequented by the rich and famous, and the other the classic seaside resort.

Castel del Monte, Trani BARI Sat 26 Oct

This morning we visit another UNESCO World Heritage Site, the Castel del Monte, icon of the

region, followed by Trani, considered to be the "Pearl of the Adriatic".

Sun 27 Oct BARI

> We visit the capital of Puglia this morning with our guide, after which you are free to do some last-minute shopping. A farewell dinner is scheduled for the evening to conclude our tour.

Mon 28 Oct Transfer will be provided in the late morning from your hotel to Bari airport.

- 1. Transfer from Bari Airport is provided at 11am on Tuesday 15 October 2019, timed to the arrival of Turkish Airlines flight TK1445. For arrivals at other times or transfers to and from other locations please contact Ergo: Travel for alternative arrangements.
- 2. Although the programme is planned to be leisurely, comfortable walking shoes are strongly recommended as there will be substantial walking on both paved and unpaved ground.
- 3. As autumn weather can be unpredictable, participants are advised to carry a small umbrella with them. There will also be visits to exposed locations where temperatures can be lower than expected.
