



Naples & the Amalfi Coast 2026 – Tour Programme



Day 1 – Saturday 11 April (Lunch, overnight in NAPLES)

We kick off the tour in Naples with a light lunch, followed by an introductory walking tour through the Historic Centre in the afternoon to reveal the exuberance of Neapolitan culture.

Day 2 – Sunday 12 April (Lunch, overnight in NAPLES)

This morning, we visit the National Archaeological Museum to see its extraordinary collection of ancient artifacts, including some of the incredible mosaics from Pompeii, followed by a pizza lunch in a restaurant made famous by the legendary Sofia Loren. The afternoon is left at your leisure with unlimited free travel on local public transport.

Day 3 – Monday 13 April (Lunch, overnight in NAPLES)

This day is spent exploring Cumae, the most ancient Greek settlement on the Italian peninsula, as well as the other-worldly landscapes of the Phlegraean Fields, an area pockmarked with volcanic craters, some of which are still active!

Day 4 – Tuesday 14 April (Lunch, overnight in AMALFI)

After a leisurely morning, we leave Naples and make our way to the town of Agerola for lunch, following which we will head for Amalfi where we shall enjoy a tour of the seaside town with a local guide.

Day 5 – Wednesday 15 April (overnight in AMALFI)

This day is left free to let you to relax and explore. Walk the quaint streets of Amalfi and Atrani next door, visit the beautiful towns of Ravello and Positano by bus, or just read a book lounging on the beach if you feel like it. The more adventurous can attempt to walk the trails hugging the spectacular coast.

Day 6 – Thursday 16 April (Dinner, overnight in AMALFI)

Today we travel south of the Amalfi coast to visit a dairy farm to taste the exquisite mozzarella freshly made from buffalo milk. Paestum is scheduled for the afternoon, where we shall see the site of an ancient Greek city with some of the best-preserved Doric temples in Europe.

Day 7 – Friday 17 April (Lunch, overnight in ANACAPRI)

The morning shall be left at your leisure, but after lunch we shall make our way to Capri on a private boat, allowing you to enjoy the spectacular coastline which UNESCO has designated as a World Heritage Site for its outstanding cultural value... even the overland journey to our hotel in the town of Anacapri is a thrill not to be missed!

Day 8 – Saturday 18 April (Dinner, overnight in ANACAPRI)

A tour of Capri town is scheduled for this morning, after which you shall be left free to continue your exploration of the island until our dinner back in Anacapri.

Day 9 – Sunday 19 April (Lunch, overnight in SORRENTO)

This morning, we visit the nearby Villa San Michele to enjoy the gardens of this historic home and to marvel at the breathtaking panoramic view of Capri. Following our lunch, we shall first travel down to the port of Capri and then transfer from there to the town of Sorrento on the mainland by private boat.

Day 10 – Monday 20 April (overnight in SORRENTO)

The day is left free to let you savour Sorrento the way it should be done – without a schedule to limit your enjoyment of what is possibly Europe's most famous seaside resort.

Day 11 – Tuesday 21 April (Lunch, overnight in NAPLES)

We take it very leisurely this morning as we check out of Sorrento and make our way to Vico Equense for lunch, after which we shall visit the archaeological site of Herculaneum before we settle down in Naples for the night.

Day 12 – Wednesday 22 April (Dinner, overnight in NAPLES)

We shall do an early excursion to Mount Vesuvius this morning, which will allow you spectacular views of the entire Gulf of Naples along with the awe-inspiring crater. The afternoon is dedicated to Pompeii, possibly the most famous ancient Roman town second only to Rome itself, followed by a visit to the site of Oplontis, a fabulous villa also buried by the eruption of Vesuvius. Dinner is scheduled this evening in a nearby pizzeria.

Day 13 – Thursday 23 April (Dinner, overnight in NAPLES)

We visit the Royal Palace and Gardens in Caserta this morning, a UNESCO World Heritage Site often used as a filming location in movies. The afternoon is again at your leisure upon returning to Naples to relax before enjoying our final dinner of the tour.

Day 14 – Friday 24 April

Tour ends after breakfast this morning.
